# My **discretion** around final grades

- I will only **downwardly** revise your self-assigned grade if it is in strong contrast to the feedback from other group members or if I have specific concerns about your participation in the final project.
- In this (fairly unlikely) scenario, I will reach out to you ahead of time with my specific concerns so that you have an opportunity to respond.
- **One exception:** A-pluses are given rather than self-assigned. This gives me an opportunity to recognize exceptional individual and group work and contributions to the class.
